By Train

Station: London Bridge

By Tube

London Bridge is the nearest tube station and is served by the Northern Line. Monument is a short walk away across London Bridge and is served by the District and Circle lines.

By Bus

The following buses stop at London Bridge Station or near Guy's Hospital:

Routes: D1, P3, P11, 17, 21, 22A, 35, 40, 43, X43, 47, 48, 133, 344, 501, 521.

By Car

There is an NCP car park close to the hospital grounds with access from Newcomen Street.

Disabled Car-Parking / Access

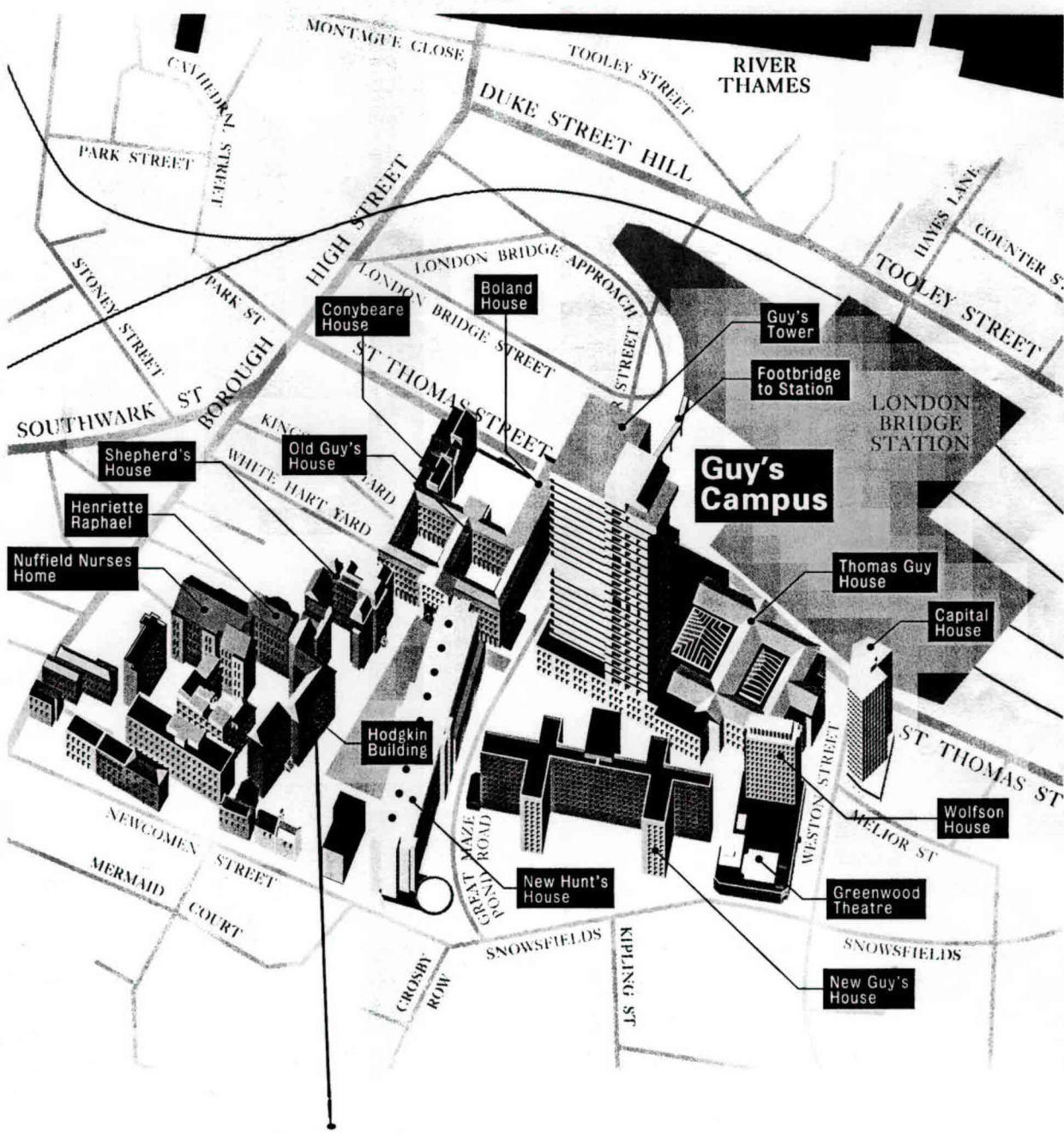
Security staff will endeavour to make sure that disabled patients and drivers who are setting down or collecting patients are given priority on site and will not have to pay for parking.

Most pedestrian access points to the buildings within the hospital grounds are suitable for wheelchair access and there are disabled toilet facilities in key locations around the site. Please ask a member of staff to direct you.

How to reach Shepherd's House

1. From London Bridge Station take the footbridge which is signposted to Guy's Hospital.
2. As you come over the footbridge, fork right, proceeding down the steps (ie do not enter the Hospital via Thomas Guy House).
3. At the bottom of the steps turn right and proceed along the footpath for approximately 30 metres, along Great Maze Pond.
4. You will arrive at the Friends of Guy's Hospital Gift Shop on the corner of a right-hand turn. Take the right-hand turning, crossing to the other side of the road at the zebra crossing.
5. Shepherd's House is a Georgian Building, which is 20 yards or so in front of you.
