At our open day you will have the opportunity to meet newly qualified pharmacists and representatives from the 42 NHS trusts that provide pre-reg programmes in our region as well as representatives from Primary Care/ Community Pharmacy. There will also be an initial presentation on the Oriel System, preferencing and how to make the most of the day.

A centralised recruitment and selection process for pre-registration pharmacist posts in England and Wales was introduced in 2017. This process utilises the Oriel IT system; through the system only one application is required in order for you to apply for all of the posts advertised. You will be able to preference all posts, both hospital and primary care. It is important that you think carefully about the type of environment that you work and learn best in. There are many factors which may influence your preferences including location, employer type, size of organisation or specialty. You can get all your questions answered and find out about programmes you may not have considered.
