Overview of course; CEPIP is a 9-month course that includes 195 hours of teaching: Face to Face days: 10 (75hrs) and 16days (120hours) E-Learning with an additional 6 hours of assessment commitment.

Number of practice hours **mandated**: minimum of 110 hours (90 prescribing and 20 assessment skills)

Number of self-directed learning hours: minimum 295 hours

Number of practice hours **mandated**: 110 hours (78 prescribing, 20 assessment skills and 12 a mixture of applied Prescribing and assessment skills)

Number of self-directed learning hours: 308 hours
